Heated Towel Rail

Without the electric extension legs:

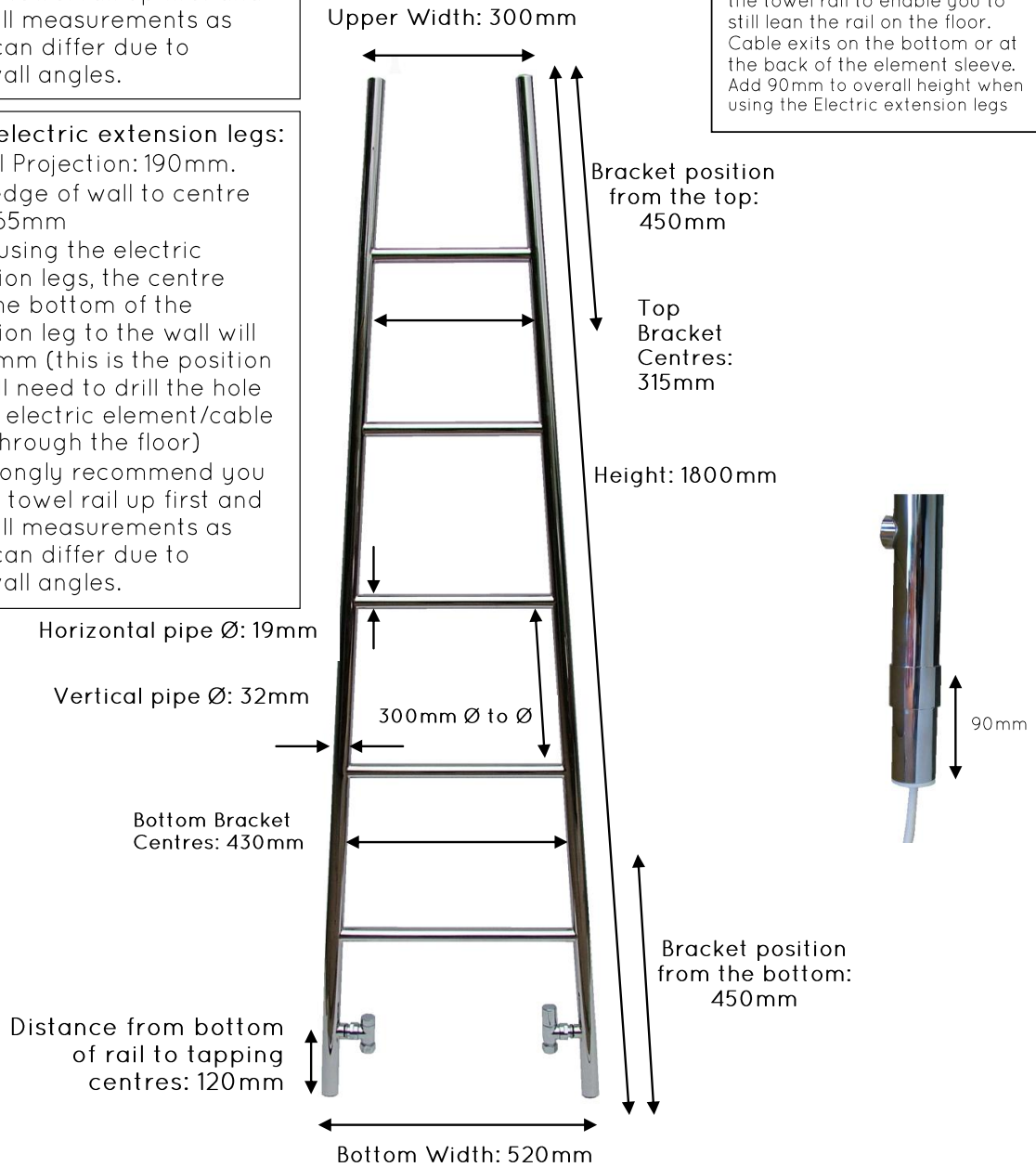
- Overall Projection: 185mm.
- From wall to pipe centre: 160mm
- We strongly recommend you set the towel rail up first and mark all measurements as these can differ due to floor/wall angles.

With the electric extension legs:

- Overall Projection: 190mm.
- From edge of wall to centre pipe: 165mm
- When using the electric extension legs, the centre from the bottom of the extension leg to the wall will be 175mm (this is the position you will need to drill the hole for the electric element/cable to go through the floor)
- We strongly recommend you set the towel rail up first and mark all measurements as these can differ due to floor/wall angles.

ELECTRIC ONLY OR DUAL FUEL FORMAT

When ordered in electric only format, two special element cover sleeves are supplied with the towel rail to enable you to still lean the rail on the floor. Cable exits on the bottom or at the back of the element sleeve. Add 90mm to overall height when using the Electric extension legs

Care and Maintenance Instructions

IMPORTANT NOTES:

Please Read Carefully & retain these instructions for Future Reference.

General Product Notes

Shelby Leaning Ladder Rail 520mm (w) 1800mm (h).

Available in central heating and standard electric formats.

In addition to the rail you will need to choose a suitable heating accessories pack. *(If ordering an electric element, we will always supply installed on the right hand side, unless requested otherwise)

100% Stainless Steel.

Available in Polished, Matt Black and Brushed Satin Finishes.

This model has side tapping's so the pipe centres will be dependent on the type of valves. We would advise having the rail and valves on site before installing your first fix.

Supplied with its own brackets. The top brackets are 60mm and the bottom brackets are 120.5mm, to allow the rail to lean against the wall in a fixed position.

When ordered in electric only, two special elements cover sleeves are supplied with the towel rail to enable you to still stand the rail on the floor and lean against the wall.

We recommend satin valves to compliment the matt black finish rail.

** Please note that when this rail is Electric Only the overall height of rail will increase to 1890mm.

25 Year guarantee on the rail body and finish in Polished and Brushed Satin, 5 year on the finish in Matt Black.

USE:

General Care & Maintenance

Provided this product is installed & used in accordance with the instructions, problems should not arise. However, should maintenance be required it should be carried out by a competent person with reference to the instructions. Before any work is carried out the root cause of the problem must be identified.

Under normal circumstances, towel rail surfaces are highly durable however small scratches / marks may occur, if the rail is a Polished Finish these can generally be polished out using a specialist Stainless Steel Metal Polish. If your rail is a Satin or Black Finish please contact us for advice before attempting to polish out any small scratches / marks.

Cleaning

We recommend using a Micro-Fibre Cloth designed for use on Stainless Steel. All that is needed to clean the products is water. Under no circumstances use abrasive, caustic or scouring products as these may adversely affect the finish of the rail. Avoid using chemical cleaners on nearby surfaces such as chemical Tile Cleaners etc as these may cause damage. Limescale ~ should a build-up of limescale occur, it can usually be removed using a 50:50 solution of white vinegar & water applied with a soft cloth & rinsed / dried thoroughly afterwards.

Guarantees

Guarantees in all cases are subject to the products being installed in accordance with British standards as well as those directed by the installation instructions. The guarantee in all cases is restricted to a free of charge replacement or repair of the failed product only. Claybrook Studio Ltd liability will under no circumstances extend beyond the repair or replacement of the product.
